Discussion

- In light of JCC leaving the League, Rob Barton (Granada Hills) ask been asked to take the position of League Secretary for the 2011 season
- 2011 Season League Meeting Schedule
 - February 1 – Bylaws, Jobs, etc.

 - March 22 – Approve Schedule

 - June 7th – Champs Meeting

- State of the Treasury
 - Treasurer not present at meeting to give report.
 - 2011 dues likely to be \$10-13/swimmer
 - Will review budget at March 1 meeting
- Pam Losefsky indicated that Minerva Martinez has offered to conduct stroke and turn judge training again this year.
- Possibly train starters at the same meeting. Utilize starter training DVD across different teams to standardize starter training.
- By March 1st meeting, each team needs to submit their meet date preferences and blackout dates.
- Two teams will probably need to host three meets this year
 - Circle C said maybe – If so, wants first three consecutive meets
 - Courtyard is going to investigate hosting a meet

- Consideration to change 12-under relays from 100's to 200's.
 - Pros and cons were discussed
 - Changing to 200's will mean the addition of 4 events (11-12 Boys/Girls Free & Medley Relays) to each meet
 - Issue was tabled until next meeting so each team can discuss internally. Will be voted on at next meeting
- Champs
 - Role of Marshall's should be stressed and enforced
 - Possible Special T-Shirt or Vests so that Marshall's will stand out
 - Need better communication of League rules to coaches. Possibly hold Coaches' meeting prior to Champs (like are held for the other volunteer positions)
- Software
 - Only 2-3 teams upgraded to Meet Manager Ver. 3.0 last year.
 - Dave indicated that all versions should integrate regardless of age
 - Highest version of Team Manager available is 6.0
 - All of the versions of software should be compatible if properly utilized
 - All teams to bring a list of the software and versions that they are using to the next meeting.
