

Capitol City Swim League
Minutes from the March 1, 2011 Meeting

The meeting commenced at 12:00. Present were Rebecca Berryman (SH), Amy Sasser (TC), Carl Jacquin (TC), Rob Barton (GHWO), Kathy Slesnick (CYTC), Jennifer Smiley (CCS), Dave Brown (HSC), Tammy Scott (BEL), Danica Geeslin, (SAAB). All clubs were represented.

Discussion

- Amy Sasser (TC), Vice-President has agreed to assume secretary duties for the League in light of JCC's departure
- Finances
 - 2011 Budget Review
 - Proposed 2011 budget reviewed
 - Motion made by GHWO to set 2011 League dues at \$12/swimmer. Seconded by BEL. Motion was passed unanimously
 - 2011 League Dues
 - First payment for estimated 2011 dues will be due at the Board meeting.
 - Second payment for remaining actual dues will be due at the first Champs Meeting
 - Make checks payable to Capitol City Summer League
- 11/12 Relay Changes
 - The floor was opened to discuss changing the 11/12 relays from 100M to 200M. A motion was made by HSC to approve the change. It was seconded by GHWO. All were in favor of the change except SH who voted against. The motion carried.
 - The floor was opened to discuss whether to create a new event for the 11/12 relays or to incorporate them into the 13+ group. A motion was made by SH to create a new event for 11/12 relays. Seconded by HSC. The motion did not carry. As such the relays will now be 11+ in the same event. Significant discussion ensued. A suggestion was made by SAAB that we consider taking the issue back to our individual teams and potentially opening again for discussion at the next League meeting. Everyone seemed amenable to that suggestion.
- Software
 - It was announced that after further investigation, the software issues that had been mentioned at the previous meeting are actually a moot point as Hytek 2.0 and 3.0 will integrate just fine (League uses 2.0. UT facility uses 3.0)
 - Active Endurance has no online meet sign up available yet.
- 2011 Season Schedule
 - Each team let the Rebecca Berryman (SH) know of any preferred dates, black-out dates, and specific meet requirements.
 - Rebecca will put together a proposed schedule that will be voted on at the next League meeting.
- Stroke/Turn/Starter Clinics
 - Minerva Martinez has agreed to conduct Stroke & Turn Clinics for the 2011 season.
 - Shady Hollow has one set up with her on May 1st. There will be a Starter Clinic beginning at approximately 4:15 pm, with the Stroke and Turn Clinic to immediately follow at 4:30 pm.
 - Three clinics total are needed. Both Circle C and GHWO said they could possibly host one. Monday, Wednesday, Fridays are best for Minerva. Clinics last about 1 hour. All stroke and turn judges must attend at least one clinic. Any club that is willing to host a training should email their proposed dates to Rebecca Berryman and she will coordinate with Minerva.

- The League provided each club with a starter training DVD and is strongly suggesting that any individual who will be performing starting duties review it. Rebecca asked Dave to please create a standardized starter script that we can utilize in training and at the meets.
- There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 12:50 pm.
