TRAINING

Minerva was present at the meeting and put forth several questions regarding how the League wants the judges instructed with regard to interpretation of the rules. She indicated that it doesn't matter if the League wants to waiver from some of the USA Swimming guidelines, but that it needs to be consistent across all of the member clubs. Dave suggested the formation of a Technical Committee who will address these issues and make suggestions to the League. Rob Barton (GHWO), Dave Brown (HSC) and Colin Smiley (CCS) volunteered to be on the committee. They will come up with a proposal to be presented at the next League meeting for Minerva to utilize in her training to ensure consistency. They will also prepare a standard Starter Script to be utilized by all the clubs.

Each team is to provide two trained starters. They should ideally review the video that the League has provided, but more importantly must attend one of the starter trainings with Minerva.
