April 13, 2010

Called to order by Rebecca Berryman.
9 members in attendance.

Champs Assignments: It is a transition year, so think about what volunteer position your team would like to lead at Champs.

Team Quality Award: Thank you, Rob, for your work on this issue. The team rank award will remain the same. A Quality Rank will be added under the name "Quality Club Award". It will be a first place only award, with restrictions removed from scoring, based on the number of swimmers from each team. In essence, it is a ratio score. Instituting the Quality Club Award at this year's Champs was passed unanimously.

Ribbons: League will provide heat ribbons for all teams. Please send Kevin your swimmer estimates for the season for the purpose of purchasing the correct number of ribbons.

Stroke and Turn: Minerva will be teaching three clinics: April 25, 6pm at Shady Hollow; May 6, 7pm at Grenada Hills Western Oaks; Saturday, May 8, 4:30, location tbd.

Training information and materials are posted at the league website.

The DVD for each team should be available at the next meeting.

Rebecca is authorized to purchase a gift card (\$50 per service) in thanks to Minerva for helping train the stroke and turn judges.

Circle C has a proposed plan for the 10 lane meet and stroke and turn judges. They will have Minerva examine it and try it out at the first meet, making changes as necessary, so all teams are content.

6 and Under Champs: After much discussion, it was motioned, seconded, and approved that this year's Champs Meet follow Option 2, with specific tweaks to make it work, especially in accordance with time and crowd control. We will have three sessions in one day with 6 and under swimmers swimming on one side of the pool in a separate session.

It will be up for discussion at the conclusion of the season to determine if this scenario will work in the future or if a separate meet should be held elsewhere for the 6 and unders at Champs. Rebecca noted this might be a good fit for the JCC's second meet as it is an 8 lane pool.
